"This motion requests that Louth County Council staff, management and elected representatives receive training in trauma-informed practices. Many of the people accessing a wide spectrum of services in LCC have experienced Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) and/or trauma in their lives.

Trauma is a widespread, harmful and costly public health problem that impacts on every facet of society. The training would:

- Embed ACEs and Trauma Informed Practice knowledge across Louth County Council to improve outcomes for children, families and adults who have been impacted by adversity.
- Assist Louth County Council to continue to develop their workforces to raise awareness of childhood adversity and trauma sensitive approaches to practice through leadership, policy and practice."
