**9.0 Notice of Motion - Cllr. Michelle Hall**

"That this council will consider installing traffic calming measures at Waterunder, Mell (R168) including dip warning signs; 2 x zebra crossings at tactile paving; 4 x yellow boxes at residents homes (3) and Barrack Lane; flashing feedback signs; and cushion ramps. This stretch of road from the M1 Retail Park roundabout has a very high volume of traffic, no speed limit signs, a hidden dip in the road and pedestrians having to walk on the road or cross the footpath with no traffic calming measures. Residents have excessively long delays in exiting their driveways/lane and experienced dangerous overtaking near their properties."

**10.0 Notice of Motion - Cllr. Michelle Hall**

"Louth County Council will install traffic calming measures at the junction of Ballymakenny Road and Cockle Road on approach towards Termonfeckin. This will include additional high visible signage on approach, cushion ramps, line markings and barriers near adjacent properties. There have been several serious road traffic accidents at this location and a bad bend on the Ballymakenny Road."
