Notice of Motions

7.0 Notice of Motion - Cllr James Byrne - Postponed from July 2025

That Louth County Council provides additional parking facilities in St Dominic's Park for those wishing to access the Boyne Greenway, separate to the planned upgrade to the existing playground and parking.

8.0 Notice of Motion - Cllr James Byrne

The Louth County Council installs traffic calming measures at Lower Mell, specifically between the Montessori/Church and the Circle K. This is in response to a serious accident on the stretch of road recently and numerous minor collisions in recent times.

9.0 Notice of Motion - Cllr Ejiro O'Hare Stratton

That Louth County Council assess and urgently install a convex traffic safety mirror at the intersection of Constitution Hill and Drogheda Road, specifically in front of No. 9 Constitution Hill, Drogheda. This is in

response to a persistent and serious road safety concern caused by significantly limited visibility at the junction.

Due to the position and overhang of a building at the corner, drivers ascending from the quay via Constitution Hill cannot see vehicles approaching from their left on Drogheda Road, and vice versa.

The blind spot created by the building structure presents a continuous danger to drivers and pedestrians. A mirror at this location would significantly improve visibility and reduce the risk of accidents. We request a site visit to assess feasibility and proceed with installation.

10.0 Notice of Motion - Cllr Eric Donovan

I am calling on the council to write to the NTA to request that the 182 Bus from Monaghan to Navan includes an extra stop in their Drogheda rural route. The request is that the bus that picks up in Tullyallen every 2 hours will include a stop at the M1 Retail Park which it drives very close to and has the infrastructure to do so. This additional stop would accommodate and benefit the Tullyallen constituency.

11.0 Notice of Motion - Cllr Ejiro O'Hare Stratton

That this Borough District of Drogheda:

1. Writes to the National Transport Authority (TFI) to express full support for the installation of a public water refill station at Drogheda Bus Station, as a necessary amenity for commuters and a step towards reducing single-use plastic bottle waste.

2. Requests Louth County Council to urgently service and maintain the existing water refill stations located:
 - At the corner of West Street and Shop Street (by the Tholsel), and

 - On George's Street (at the bus stop beside the disused public toilets), ensuring they are clean, functional, and regularly maintained, especially during peak footfall periods such as festivals and public events.

This motion is made in support of ongoing efforts by local organisations, including the Drogheda Commuter Coalition, to improve public infrastructure, sustainability, and the overall experience of residents and visitors in Drogheda.
