"I am calling on the Borough District to write to the Minister for Health, Stephen Donnelly, requesting him to fast track children with Spina Bifida and/or Hydrocephalus currently requiring urgent Orthopaedic intervention, for surgical review as a matter of urgency. I am also calling on the Minister for Health to ensure that provision of services is made to Disabled Children within elective Hospital settings as well as acute Hospital settings to avoid a repeat of this situation in the future."
