### **Minute No. 46/21**

### **Confirmation of Minutes**

The minutes of the monthly meeting held on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> April 2021 were confirmed on the proposal of Cllr. Michelle Hall and seconded by Cllr. Joanna Byrne.

### **Minute No. 47/21**

### **Matters Arising**

Minute 34/21 stated that a presentation on the Outdoor Dining Scheme would be arranged for May but was not on agenda. Paddy Donnelly Director, advised that a presentation would be arranged when there was an update available.

### **Minute No. 48/21**

### **Housing Progress Report**

Members discussed the report as circulated at the meeting. Director of Services, Paddy Donnelly addressed all matters raised by the Members.

The following items were clarified:

- Housing are meeting with the Department to set realistic targets as where previous targets were exceeded the target was then increased.
- Increase in grant applications has seen more staff allocated to grants on full time basis and a change to the application period which is now open all year round. Grant funding is always used in full.
- While everyone on transfer list deserving of transfer, the ability to transfer all on list is not straightforward. Challenge to avoid void creation.

- Retrofit scheme is for tenanted properties only. Housing officials are hopeful of void scheme funding announcement.

### **Minute No. 49/21**

#### **Operations and Marine Progress Report**

Members discussed the report as circulated at the meeting.  
Mark Johnson, Senior Engineer addressed all Operations Matters raised.

The following items were highlighted:

- Business owners have responsibility for litter within 100m of premises
- Cleaning crew back working fully, non routine special cleaning can now be tackled
- Clogherhead Carpark will be resurfaced and include kerbing and EV chargers
- Operations exploring possible pedestrianisation options in town
- Engineers willing to meet interested parties on Sunday's Gate remedial proposals

Members were advised to refer items raised on PANCR and the Obelisk Bridge to Infrastructure. Operations will examine issue of running water from railway bridge and coordinate with Irish Rail/Irish Water as necessary.
