That Louth County Council install dished curbs at the footpath on Dublin Road adjacent to Chapel Rd and fairways. This will allow pedestrians with pushchairs utilise the dished traffic island as indicated in the attached photograph

#### **9.0 Notice of Motion - Cllr. Sean Kelly**

'That Louth Council look at the possibility of installing two new pedestrian crossings at the following locations:

1. Outside of Castletown Pharmacy on the Castletown Road, Dundalk.
2. At the entrance of Aisling Park playground at Marian Park, Dundalk.

The rationale behind this is the fact that there is no other means for pedestrians to cross in close vicinity and there are a lot of children and elderly people using both roads on a frequent basis, therefore the lack of a pedestrian crossing is a significant safety concern.'
