I observed in Castlebellingham, co. Louth the following:

1. The village has many derelict idle buildings in the main street, these are taking away from the ascetics from the village, also a few years ago Foley`s tearoom has been destroyed by fire & there seems to be no movement in assistance to help rebuild this once popular business.
2. There is no suitable car park in the village which takes away from business, not attracting customers on the main street.
3. There are no suitable walking routes. I would suggest one beside the Glyde river to the village playground or a Greenway (Bike lanes) at the sea bank road - Castlebellingham linking Blackrock to allow for outdoor activities to improve wellbeing & fitness.
4. Promotion of Castlebelingham History & Tidy towns funding towards a heritage garden for local pensioners to enjoy.
