My other child is married and living in South Louth and has no requirement to build in this area, and therefore this site would be required for one house only.

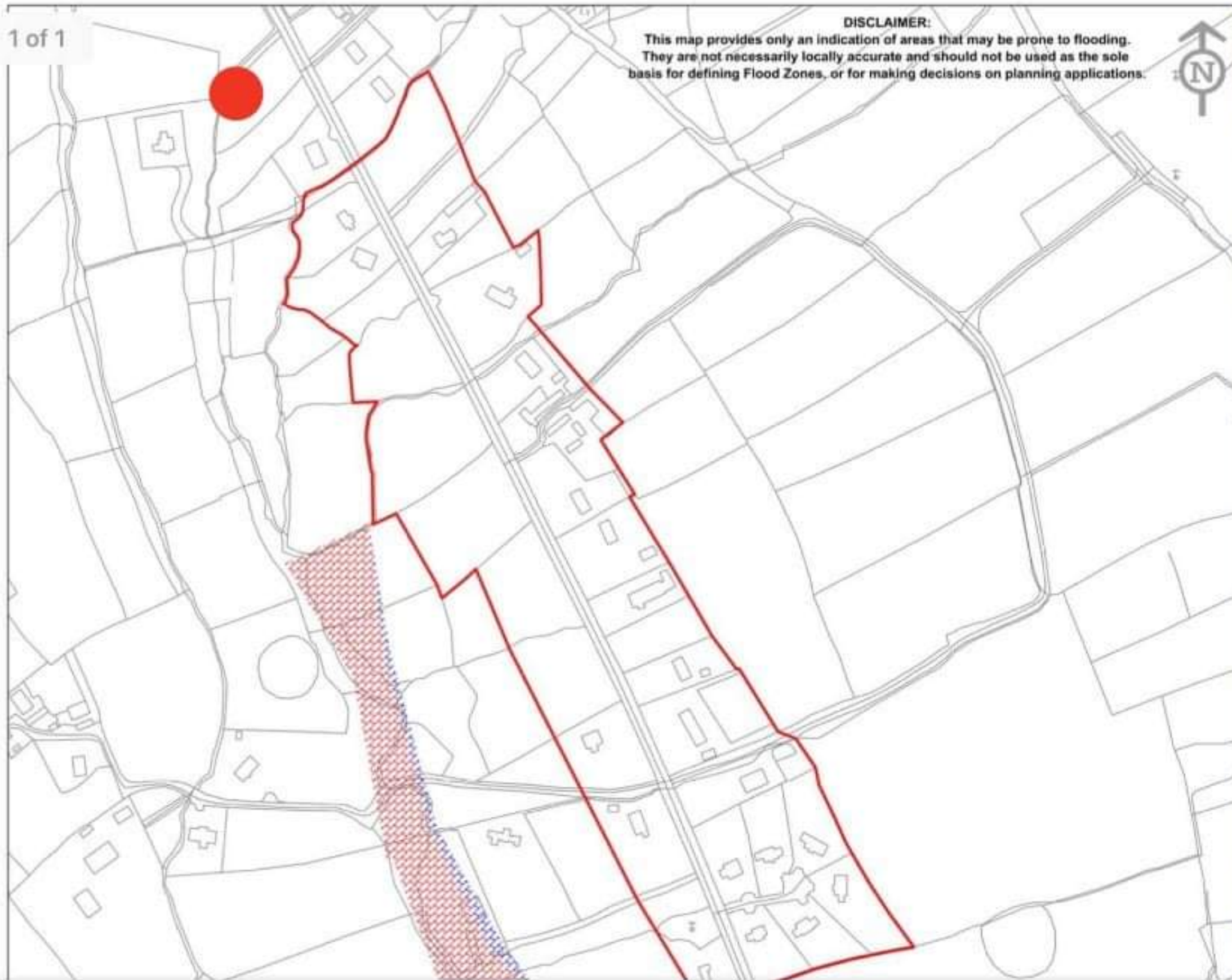
This is the only land that my family owns, by having nearby it would offer both my wife and I great comfort as we get older.
