As a resident in Rural Cooley Peninsula I want to make a formal objection to the Louth County Development Plan 2021-2027.

I am making my objection on the following grounds.

As a resident of the Omeath rural community, I have not been asked or consulted on major changes to be included in the Louth County Development Plan 2021-2027.

Based on the major changes outlined in the Louth County Development Plan 2021-2027 there seems to have been no Impact Assessment Report commissioned or completed showing the long term affects on our communities.

During Covid-19 there has not been the availability for affected communities to meet, discuss, challenge or put forward alternatives to the Plan.

The Louth County Development Plan 2021-2027 makes no provision for my sons or any children in the area to create a home and continue to live in our communities. We demand provisions in the plan to allow this and thus allow for our community to sustain long into the future.

I feel that the rural way of life and the many benefits it offers to people and communities is at risk. My family have our roots in our town land for over 100 years and it saddens me to think that my own children they will not have the opportunity to raise their own families here.

I ask that proper care and consideration is given to the matter.
