Therefore, I would like to propose the following for criteria of Zone One:

A Native resident who is seeking to build a house in the area. A native resident is someone who has resided in the rural area of the county for at least 18 years prior to any application for planning permission. Any applicant in this category must demonstrate rural housing need.

I believe that tighter restrictions on planning regulations that will both protect the local environment but will ensure that local families who have lived in an area for generations, are entitled to live for future generations to come.
