Dear Mr Pentony,

I am writing to you in connection with the proposed county plan for 2021-2027, and am requesting an amendment in regard to my own property, and the property of the late Anne Thompson in Ballintесkin, Omeath.

On the proposed plan, my home, and the fields behind my house are shown to be part of flood zone A (Please see the attached maps for details). My dwelling is on an elevated site. It was inspected by our current insurance company and was deemed to be approx 7 meters above the level of the Ryland river. I am requesting that my property be removed from flood zone A, as we have previously had issues securing insurance due to the proximity of the river. Due to the elevated position of the house on the site, there is absolutely no risk of flooding from the Ryland river.

Also shown in flood zone A on Composite Omeath Map 3B, are fields behind my house which also do not flood as they are higher than the river (please see the attached maps). Please could these also be removed from flood zone A?

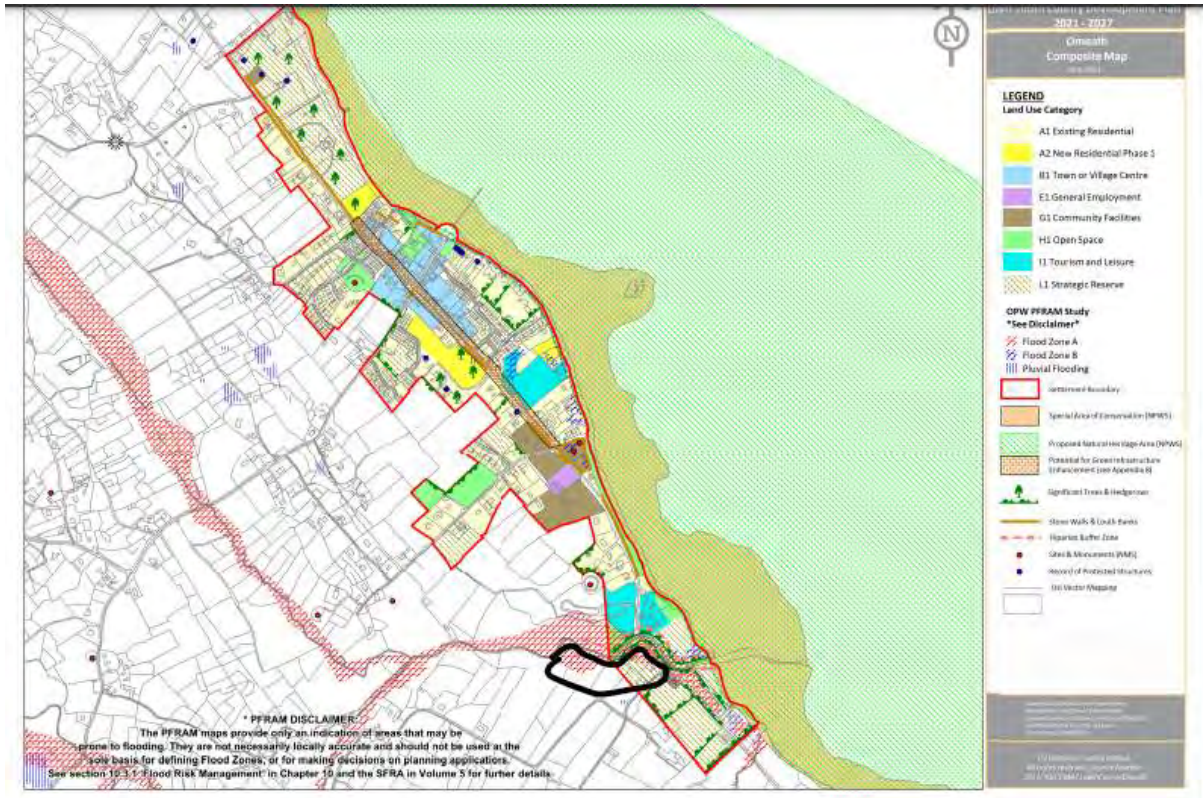

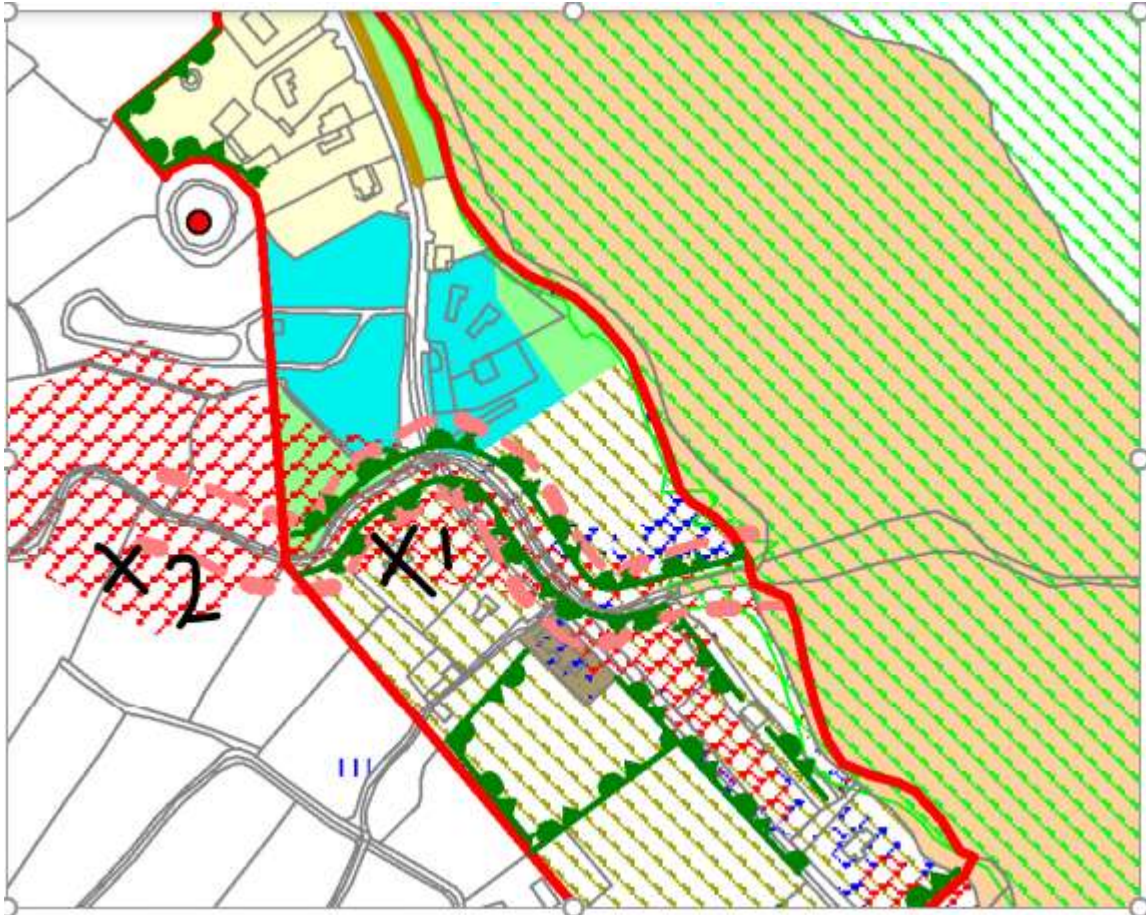

My property is shown as part of the flood zone A. This is inaccurate, as the Carlingford side of the Ryland at this point is higher than the Omeath side of the river. The flood zone shown inside the black circle does not experience flooding.
