

1 Ardee Municipal District Operations

Mid Louth North

Works carried out in the past month include the following:

Patching/pothole repairs at various locations including Reaghstown, Arthurstown, Rathory, Green Rd at Louth Village, Darver, Cavanrobert, Seabank, Pepperstown X to Charlestown, Cooper's X at Castlebellingham, Rosybrook, Flowery X to Lagan Rd, Knockaboys, Mansfieldtown to Newtowndarver, Cardistown, Stonetown & Crowmartin.

Drainage maintenance works were carried out at the following locations: Duffy's X to Tallanstown, Corderry and Whiterath to Newtowndarver. Gully cleaning/jetting works were carried out at various locations. Drainage improvement works were completed at both Mansfieldtown & Tallanstown, to remediate surface water issues at those locations.

Preparation of roads for surface dressing continued with preparation work at Commons Rd and Little Rd Dromiskin. These works involve ploughing/scraping back verges, drainage maintenance/improvement works and patching/pothole repair.

Refuse from public bins was collected weekly. The playgrounds & ring buoys were checked weekly also.

Mid Louth South

Road maintenance operations including patching and pothole repairs were carried out at various locations including: - LS5210 Mount Rush, N2 Collon, LP2250, LP2295, LP2226-64, LS5257 at Roestown and LS5256.

There is also ongoing works taking place getting the various roads ready for surface dressing.

Drainage maintenance, such as opening of drainage outlets, back-drains and cleaning of gullies, is continuing on an ongoing basis at various locations including: - R132 Dunleer - Drogheda, LP1212, N2 Collon, LP2225 at Hoathstown,

Litter collection, playground inspections, lifebuoy inspections and routine graveyard maintenance are ongoing on a weekly basis throughout the area including Various locations

Other road maintenance operations such as maintaining, cleaning and replacing of road signage, repairing pedestrian railing, removal of vegetation around signs and traffic light maintenance was undertaken at various locations throughout the area including: - Life Buoy and warning signs at Salterstown Pier and LS6248.

Road markings to regulate parking and maintain traffic flows are continuing on an ongoing basis. Works are prioritised due to limited resources and carried out when the weather is suitable.

2. Borough District of Drogheda Operations

Road maintenance operations, such as patching and pothole repairs have been carried out at various locations across the road network including: - Patrick Street, Boyne Road, Done Road, Cement Road, Cross Lanes at the Hospital, Cement Road, Newtown Road and Bredin Street.

Drainage maintenance, such as cleaning of road gullies is continuing on an ongoing basis at various locations throughout the Town.

Other road maintenance operations such as maintaining and replacing road signage, traffic light maintenance, barrier and bollard repairs was undertaken at various locations throughout the Town area including: - St. Laurence's Gate,

Road markings to regulate parking and maintain traffic flows are continuing on an ongoing basis throughout the Town. Works are prioritised due to limited resources. Traffic Calming road markings are also being carried out throughout the Town.

Litter collection, playground and skate-park inspections and lifebuoy inspections are ongoing on a weekly basis.

South Louth District Area.

Road maintenance operations, such as patching and pothole repairs have been carried out at:- Ganderstown, Link Road at Rosehall, Almondstown Road, Dowth Road, Hamlinstown Road, Tower Road at Monasterboice and the R166 Togher – Murray's Cross.

There is also ongoing works taking place getting the various roads ready for surface dressing.

Other road maintenance operations such as maintaining and replacing road signage were undertaken at various locations throughout the area including: - Bridge Repairs at Termonfeckin and Litter League signs at Monasterboice.

Drainage maintenance is continuing on an ongoing basis throughout the area including opening and re-opening verge cuts along various roads including: - R132, R166 Togher – Murray's Cross, Townrath Road at Ballymakenny, Townleyhall Road at Tullyallen and Rathdrummin Road at Grangebellew.

Road markings were also being carried out at various locations throughout the area.

Litter collection, the collection of illegal dumping, playground inspections, lifebuoy inspections and general graveyard maintenance are carried out on a weekly basis throughout the area.

3. Municipal District of Dundalk

Blackrock Faughart Area

Works carried out in the past month include the following:

Preparation of roads for surface dressing continued at Maghereagh-Belrobin, Little Ash, Belrobin to the N53, Faughart Hill, and Balregan to Kilcurry. These works involve ploughing/scraping back verges, drainage maintenance/improvement works and patching/pothole repair.

Street cleaning and emptying of litter bins is ongoing with bins emptied in Blackrock every Friday and Monday.

In Dundalk,

In **Dundalk**, works are progressing on the preparation of Drawings and Contract Documents for the 2018 Road Works Programme.

Minor repairs to roads, footpaths, signage, manhole covers and gullies are carried out as required.

White line refreshing has continued at various locations in the Town with Additional Road Marking having been placed.

A new footpath has been provided improving connection between Avenue Road and Ramparts Road/Stapelton Drive

Litter picking, emptying bins & street sweeping continues on a daily basis. Removal & disposal of dumped household and similar rubbish from public areas continues.

Maintenance of the storm sewerage network continues with blockages and flooding being cleared as required.

Traffic Light Maintenance and collision repairs continues.

In Cooley,

In **Cooley**, general maintenance of roads, footpaths, signage, gullies, drains, verges, etc has continued.

Road Drainage maintenance works continue at Ballygoly, Benagh, Moneycrockroe, Corrakit & Glenmore in preparation for Surface Dressing continues

Pothole patching has continued in Ravensdale, Glenmore, Roskey, Rath, Moneycrockroe, Corrakit & Ballygoly

Street Cleaning and Bin Collection continues in Carlingford, Omeath & Greenore.

Increased amounts of illegally dumped rubbish and tyres have been lifted at various locations. Asbestos containing materials have been dumped at a number of locations and require the services of specialist licensed Contractors to dispose off.

Gardai were assisted with Traffic Management provision/ Road Closure at RTA/ Emergency Incidents, etc.
