Admin/Biographical History: Upper Kilcrone National School was a one teacher school in mid-Louth. When it closed in the late 1960s, it amalgamated with Knockbridge National School and the last teacher gave the archives of Kilcrone NS to Knockbridge NS. The original Kilcrone NS was replaced by a new one built in 1938. See Pat O'Neill's 'History of Knockbridge' for further information.

Archival History: The punishment book was unearthed by Pat O'Donohue (last Garda Attendance Officer in Dundalk) and was donated to Louth County Archives Service in June 2016.

Scope and Content: The collection currently consists of one item, a punishment book, containing eleven entries.

Descriptive List

SCH012/PUN1

Corporal punishment book of Upper Kilcrone National School. Provides date, name of pupil, standard, offence, nature and amount of the punishment, teacher's signature, date of pupil's previous punishment (if any) and comments. Examples of offences recorded include unkindness, disobedience, beating smaller boy, for telling lies and calling teacher names.

There are eleven entries. Dates of inspection are recorded on pages. The inside cover of the book contains 'instructions in regard to the infliction of corporal punishment in national schools'.
