



## Louth 1920 Online Archives Exhibition

### Introduction

With the kind assistance of funding from the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media, we have digitised a selection of our surviving archives dating to the 1920 period, under the Decade of Centenaries Local Legacies Programme in 2020.

The purpose of developing this digital content is to support local research and scholarship by providing free online access to local archival sources and by creating this online archives exhibition to commemorate 1920. We hope that these online resources support a deeper understanding of events of the period and the impact of this in Louth.

Furthermore, digitisation supports preservation of the original books as they are not required to be handled as often. However, digitisation is costly and the more important items of large collections can only be done as financial resources allow. Researchers are encouraged to consult the [online catalogue](#) to find out more about collections, noting the collection codes on the introduction page which will assist in using the online catalogue, and the [Archive Collections](#) web-page, which is updated periodically.
