



Community Climate Action Programme – Approved Projects under Phase 2

The Community Climate Action Programme is aimed to support and help build low carbon communities across Ireland. This funding is part of the Community Climate Action Programme, which supports projects and initiatives that facilitate community climate action through education, capacity building and learning by doing. There was a total of five themes under which community groups could apply for funding (Community Energy, Travel, Food and Waste, Shopping and Recycling and Local Climate and Environmental Action).

Community groups who have applied for funding under this funding stream were required to put forward a project that delivered a direct climate benefit, under one or more of the five themes and within the programme rules and guidelines. The funding streams that were available were as follows, Small Scale Projects (up to €20,000), Medium Scale Projects (€20,000-€50,000), Large Scale Projects (€50,000- €100,000), the Community Climate Action Programme offers 100% funding for community groups to carry out their projects. The second phase of the Community Climate Action Programme opened for applications on the 28th of October 2025 and closed on 23rd December 2025.

The following projects have been allocated funding under the second phase Community Climate Action Programme. Louth County Council has been allocated a total of €651,374.78 under the second phase of the programme from the Department of Climate, Energy and Environment, a total of 17 projects have



been allocated funding. A reserve list of projects also remains in place in the event additional funding may become available under this funding stream at a later date.

Projects under Phase 2

1. **Dundalk Young Irelands GFC** have been allocated €4, 052.85 under the *Shopping and Recycling* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to install a water refill station at their club grounds.
2. **St. John of God North East Services** have been allocated €4, 500.00 under the *Local Climate and Environmental Action* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to purchase and install raised beds at their premises for residents to plant a variety of pollinators.
3. **Louth Beekeeper Association** have been allocated €16,514.89 under the *Local Climate and Environmental Action* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to purchase an Apideas mating box, Apidea top feeder and breeding chamber, 3 beekeeper suits, hive complete premier 2 supers, Hornet trap, two Hornet suits and a solar wax melter.



4. **Mattock Rangers CLG GAA Club** have been allocated €13, 650.00 under the *Community Energy* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to install solar panels at their clubhouse, the Community Climate Action Programme grant will also be combined with a grant from SEAI and SE Systems to complete this project.

5. **Ardee St. Mary's** have been allocated €17,068.00 under the *Community Energy* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to install solar panels at their clubhouse, the Community Climate Action Programme grant will also be used in conjunction with a grant from SEAI to complete this project.

6. **Drogheda Homeless Aid (DHA)** have been allocated €27, 700.00 under the *Community Energy* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to replace and upgrade the windows at their premises.

7. **Dundalk Tennis Club** have been allocated €49,355.00 under the *Community Energy* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to install solar panels and LED Lighting upgrade.

8. **Dundalk Dog Rescue** have been allocated €23,074.00 under the *Community Energy, Travel and Local Climate and Environmental Action* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to install solar

panels, install a bike shelter and plant a variety of pollinators at their premises.

9. **Oliver Plunketts GFC** have been allocated €26,414.90 under the *Community Energy and Travel* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to upgrade their lighting to LED and purchase two bike stands.
10. **Clan Na Gael GFC** have been allocated €40,000.00 under the *Community Energy and Travel* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to install solar panels and a bike shelter.
11. **Naomh Mairtin CPG** have been allocated €44, 116.48 under the *Community Energy, Travel, Food and Waste, Shopping and Recycling and Local Climate and Environmental Action* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to install solar panels on their clubhouse, sensor lighting, and outdoor water refill station, outdoor segregated waste bins, plant native hedging, a gear swap shop station and a bike shelter.
12. **Dromiskin Tidy Towns** have been allocated €49,644.90 under the *Local Climate and Environmental Action* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to carry out a Sustainable Urban Drainage (SUDs) Project at Dromiskin, County Louth.

13. **Albion Rovers Football Club** have been allocated €73,000.00 under the *Community Energy* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to upgrade the lighting at their clubs grounds to LED.

14. **Muirhevnemor Community Gardens** have been allocated €51,532.66 under the *Travel, Food and Waste, Local Climate and Environmental Action and Shopping and Recycling* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to carry out a wildlife pond restoration, two compost toilets, biodiversity planting and well-being area, bike rack and bike repair pole.

15. **Haggardstown and Blackrock Community Centre CLG** have been allocated €52,200.42 under the *Shopping and Recycling, Travel and Community Energy* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to install a rainwater harvesting system with included plumbing requirements, solar panel installation including batteries and a hot water diverter. A bike repair stand and pump, two EV charging stations, bike charging station with bollards and two second hand disability bikes.

16. **Stephenstown Pond Trust CLG** have been allocated €100,00.00 under the *Community Energy, Travel, Food and Waste, Shopping and Recycling and Local Climate and Environmental Action* theme of the

Community Climate Action Programme to carry out a community retrofit including upgrading lighting to LED, energy efficient heaters, water butts, bike shelter, water refill stations, planting of fruit and apple trees, and biodiversity planters and the purchase of two Swift boxes. The community group will also replace the windows and doors within the premises.

17. **Kilkerley Emmetts** have been allocated €58,550.68 under the *Community Energy* theme of the Community Climate Action Programme to carry out an LED lighting upgrade.
