REQUIREMENTS FOR NEWSPAPER NOTICE OF FURTHER INFORMATION (ARTICLE 35 (1) OF THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS 2006 AS AMENDED, REFERS)

The Notice must be published in an approved newspaper, containing as a heading the name of **Louth County Council**, marked “**Further Information**” stating:

- (i) the name of the applicant,
- (ii) the location, townland or postal address of the land or structure to which the application relates (as may be appropriate),
- (iii) the reference number of the application on the register,
- (iv) that *significant further information* in relation to the application has or have been furnished to the planning authority, and is or are available for inspection or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, at the offices of the authority during its public opening hours, and
- (v) a submission or observation in relation to the further information may be made in writing to the planning authority on payment of the prescribed fee of €20.00, not later than two weeks after receipt of this newspaper notice and site notice by the planning authority.
- (vi) or, in the case of a planning application accompanied by an EIS/NIS, within 5 weeks of receipt of such notices by the planning authority.
