1. Written observations or submissions should be marked **'Draft Louth County Development Plan 2021-2027'**, and submitted to Forward Planning Unit, Development Plan Review, Louth County Council, Town Hall, Crowe Street, Dundalk, Co. Louth A91 W20C.
2. Emailed submissions or observations should be marked **'Draft Louth County Development Plan 2021-2027'** in the subject line of the email and emailed to louthcdp@louthcoco.ie

Submissions or observations shall be made between **Wednesday 14th October, 2020 and Wednesday 23rd December, 2020** (both dates inclusive). Please note submissions will only be accepted up to 12pm (Noon) on Wednesday 23rd December, 2020. Late submissions will not be accepted.

Louth County Council is subject to the provisions of the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act (as amended). If you consider that any of the information supplied by you is either commercially sensitive or confidential in nature, this should be highlighted and the reasons for its sensitivity specified.
