Admin/Biographical History: The items in this collection originate from various creators and were collected by Leonard Hatrick, of Dawson's Demesne, Ardee. Leonard Hatrick was a train driver for Iarnród Éireann and a former councillor of Ardee Town Commissioners.

Archival History: The collection was donated by Leonard Hatrick in 2004.

Scope and Content: The collection contains photographs and three documents relating to Ardee and to the Hatrick family.
